We are set to open the “most effective school possible” where we “should always be having fun while creating a wonderful learning environment for students”. It made me laugh to read “early preparation is key” as a 24-year-old who had no idea what it really took to run a school, but this couldn’t be more relevant as we are just a short six months away from opening.

I am glad that 24-year-old Mike is not getting ready to open a school. As excited as I was then, I was not ready for the challenges that lie ahead. I am an older and wiser version of the guy that sent those emails and dreamed up a great school where learning and teaching were fun always. I am also still very much the same in my endless optimism about the work.

Earlier this month my grandmother, Patricia Kind, passed and I was able to join my family to celebrate her brilliant and joyous life. I think about her as she showed me each and every day how to enjoy all of the moments of the journey. The next six months will be some of the most challenging in this journey.
