The mission of Memphis Delta Preparatory (MDP) Charter School is to support and grow productive and wellrounded citizens who will succeed in college and beyond.





Reading

By spring 2024, we will improve K-5 literacy, as indicated by the following measures:

- TVAAS Level 5
- •Meet double AMO as identified by the state of Tennessee
- 60% of students meet their individual growth goals from fall to spring on NWEA MAP

Math

By spring 2024, we will improve K-5 math, as indicated by the following measures:

- TVAAS Level 5
- •Meet double AMO as identified by the state of Tennessee
- 60% of students meet their individual growth goals from fall to spring on NWEA MAP

Chronic Absenteeism

During 2023-2024, we will reduce the rate of chronic absenteeism to 36.2%.

We will increase our attendance rate to 95% or higher.

Title I

Title I

Title I was passed in 1965 under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA). It is the largest federal assistance program for our nation's schools.

Title I schools receive extra funding (Title I dollars) from the federal government. These dollars are used to:

- identify students experiencing academic difficulties and provide assistance to help these students;
- purchase additional staff, programs, materials, and/or supplies; and
- conduct parent and family engagement meetings, trainings, events, and/or activities.

Parents' Rights

The families and parents of Title I students have a right, by law, to:

- be involved in decisions made at both the school and district level;
- be provided with information on your child's level of achievement on tests in reading/language arts, writing, mathematics, and science;
- request and receive information on the qualifications of your child's teachers; and
- request opportunities for regular meetings to formulate suggestions and to participate, as appropriate, in decisions about the education of your child. The school is required to respond to any such suggestions as soon as practicably possible.

Title I Funds

In 2023-2024, our school was allotted approximately \$300,925 in Title I funding.

We developed a **School-wide Program**, which means we plan to spend our funds on the following:

- Supplemental staff: Instructional coaches and additional teachers
- Programs/Materials/Supplies
- Teacher Professional Development

School Improvement Plan (SIP)

The SIP includes...

- the identification of the school planning team and how they will be engaged in the planning process;
- a needs assessment and summary of academic and nonacademic data;
- prioritized goals, strategies, and action steps to help address the academic and non-academic needs of students;
- teacher and staff professional development needs; and
- budgets and the coordination of resources.

Family Engagement

Parent and Family Engagement Funding

For 2023-2024, we received approximately \$3,455 in Title I parent and family engagement funding. These funds are used for:

- Parent and Family Engagement Meeting and Events
- Materials/Supplies
